
Wayfarers FUN CHRISTMAS GROTTO

Winter has arrived and now the skies are at their darkest, it's a great time to see which constellations. stars and planets you can spot!

Patrick Kiernan, who runs the Planetarium at World Museum, has some top tips for what to look out for...



SEEING STARS

When you look at the night sky you can see lots of stars, at first they look like someone has just thrown them onto the sky. After a while you might see that they form patterns. Astronomers call those patterns constellations.


You don't need a telescope or anything special to see stars

One star pattern that is always visible for us is the Plough. Some people think it looks like a saucepan.

The two stars at the end of the Plough are called The Pointers because they point to the North Star -Polaris. This star always points North.

The brightest constellations in Winter are Taurus the Bull, and Orion the Hunter.

Taurus looks like a giant V on its side; above it is a faint group of stars, called the Seven Sisters. Can you see why it's called that?



Orion is chasing Taurus so appears in the sky after it; there is a red star on his right shoulder and a bright white star at his left foot. He also has a belt of three stars, hanging from it is his sword.





BRIGHT LIGHTS IN THE NIGHT SKY

Have you noticed a very bright star in the sky? It is not really a star but the planet Jupiter; the largest planet in the Solar System.

Remember to look at the Moon, our closest neighbour in space. Watch how it changes its shape - from a crescent to a round full moon. How long does it take to go from a full moon to full moon?

Sometimes you might see a bright flash of light across the sky, this is a shooting star or meteor. Shooting stars are not really stars but bits of dust that burn up in Earth's atmosphere.

OUT OF THIS WORLD SPACE FACTS

Jupiter is the biggest planet in the Solar System, it is so big that you could fit 1,300 Earths inside it.

The largest object in our Solar System is the Sun, it is much bigger than Jupiter: so big that you could fit ONE MILLION Earths inside it!!





Swimming as we all know is a life skill that everyone should have, but nearly half of all children cannot swim the length of a pool by the time they leave primary school. Why is this? Budget cuts? Maybe. Fewer swimming pools? Could be? That doesn't stop us parents from taking our children swimming ourselves. There are some fantastic pools in Sefton from Dunes in Southport, Formby Pool, Bootle Leisure Centre, Meadows Leisure Centre in Maghull and Crosby Leisure Centre. We just need to use them more.

1 in 3 children say swimming is their favourite family activity but are we as parents taking them enough and are we teaching them properly?

Swimming is great for child development. It is a unique sensory experience, which accesses all five senses: sight, hearing, smell, touch and taste. Swimming even encourages a baby to meet physical milestones more quickly e.g. sitting up, crawling, and walking. As well as being fun, swimming can aide in mobility and cardiovascular functions, increasing fitness especially in babies, enabling them to move and breathe better resulting in significant improvement in overall language communication skills. With improved coordination children can pick up other activities quicker like riding a bike, horse riding or even skateboarding. Research has also found that swimming encourages a connection between the mind and body, stimulating brain development and increasing intelligence. I should go more myself! It's a great way for improving fitness without putting stress on the skeletal form as it works the large muscles of the body, honing in on gross motor skills and building coordination. In babies, swimming has also been accredited with improved eating and sleeping behaviour immediately after a lesson.

It's never too early to start lessons as swimming at a very early age encourages a lifetime of physical activity and wellbeing, providing an early introduction into other sports and activities whilst also highly benefiting baby development. A child who has swimming lessons from an early age will develop a lifelong confidence and enjoyment of water.

With drowning now the third highest cause of death amongst children in the UK, we as parents should be doing our best to give our children this life skill. You never know when they will need it!

St John Ambulance, the nation's leading first aid charity has teamed up with All About Family to bring you some simple, but life saving, first aid tips this time: choking.

Choking is caused by a foreign object that is stuck at the back of the throat. A child may choke on food, or may put small objects into their mouth and cause a blockage of the airway.

If the blockage is severe they will be unable to speak, cough, or breathe, and will eventually lose consciousness.

If the casualty is a child or adult, follow these steps;

- Ask the casualty 'Are you choking?' If the casualty is breathing encourage them to cough.
- If they can't speak or breathe, bend them forward. Give up to five sharp blows between the shoulder blades with the heel of your hand. Check their mouth.
- If choking persists, stand behind the casualty. Put both arms around them and put one fist between the navel and the bottom of the breastbone. Grasp your fist with your other hand, and pull sharply inwards and upwards up to five times. Recheck the mouth.

· Repeat the backslaps and thrusts until the obstruction clears. If after three cycles it still has not cleared, call 999/112. Continue the sequence until help arrives. If they lose consciousness, open the airway and check breathing.

If the casualty is an infant, follow these steps;


- · Lay the baby face down on your forearm supporting the body and chin.
- Give up to five back blows between the shoulder blades with the heel of your hand, check the mouth for any obstruction and remove.
- If the obstruction hasn't cleared, turn the baby on their back. Place two fingers on the centre of the infant's chest and push inwards and upwards against the breastbone. Check the mouth for any obstruction and remove. Repeat up to five times.
- If the obstruction doesn't clear, repeat the backslaps and thrusts until the obstruction clears. If after three cycles it still has not cleared, call 999/112. Continue the sequence until help arrives.




