## Think carefully about the how the letter shapes are joined...

- There are two main joins:
  1) a diagonal join to half height
  2) a washing line join
- With letter e, the diagonal join has to sweep round to form the <u>e</u> (egg) and the washing line join has to dip down to form the <u>re</u> (are).
- When a letter that ends with a washing line join (  $\infty$ ,  $\pi$ , N, N, N) is followed by a letter in the c group ( c, a, d, s, g, o, q) a hook over is added to the washing line join to reach the starting point of the next letter ( oak, rag, van, want, exam ).
